

# UNC HEALTH VOLUNTEER VACCINE CHECKLIST

All UNC Health volunteers are required to have documented immunity to the following diseases in the following ways:

## Measles, Mumps, and Rubella One (1) of the options below:

 VACCINE: Provide official documentation of 2 MMR vaccines at least 1 month apart given after age 1 ---OR---HCP must provide documentation of individual vaccines totaling 2 Measles, 2 Mumps, and 1 Rubella vaccinations.
TITER: Provide official documentation of positive laboratory titers.

#### Varicella (Chicken Pox) One (1) of the options below:

1. VACCINE: Provide official documentation of 2 Varicella (chicken pox) vaccines or 1 Zostavax vaccine (shingles).

2. **TITER:** Provide official documentation of positive laboratory titer.

### <u>Tdap</u>

VACCINE: Provide vaccine record of one Tdap as an adult or adolescent (≥ 11 years of age).

Tuberculosis Screening One (1) of the options below: (please watch the video on our website for further explanation)

- Provide documentation of 2 separate tuberculin (TB) skin tests performed within the past 12-month period (2-step skin test). If a 2-step test was performed greater than 12 months ago, a current TB test must be completed, and documentation of your 2-step history must be provided. (The 2-step test requires 4 visits to your health provider.) The 2<sup>nd</sup> TB test should be placed at least one week AFTER the 1<sup>st</sup> one has been read/checked. If placed earlier, it will not be accepted, and a 3<sup>rd</sup> test will need to be done.
- 2. A TB blood test performed within the last 12 months will be accepted as documentation for TB testing.

\*\*If providing documentation of a chest x-ray, it must include official narrative interpretation of results by a radiologist within the past 2 years. Please also provide any documentation of latent tuberculosis treatment.

**<u>COVID</u>** Vaccine is not mandated but is recommended.

VACCINE: Provide documentation including dates, manufacturers and locations received, as well as any boosters.

### <u>Influenza</u>

**VACCINE**: Provide official documentation of vaccination for the current flu season (Sept - April/May). If you are applying outside of these dates, you do not need to provide flu vaccine documentation. We will let you know when documentation is needed for the next flu season.
