Neutrophil Function, (Oxidative Burst)

Effective July 5, 2009 the Neutrophil Function, (Oxidative Burst) Assay will become a send-out test performed by Mayo Medical Laboratories. The Neutrophil Function, (Oxidative Burst) Assay will temporarily not be performed by the Flow Cytometry Laboratory at UNC Hospitals due to issues with the current assay vendor. The Core Laboratory Referral Testing section will be responsible for sending samples during this period.

Samples can be collected and submitted to the Referral Testing Laboratory Monday – Thursday or Friday morning. The sample requirements are:

 3mL of blood in a purple top (EDTA) or green top (sodium heparin) tube on the patient. Minimum sample volume is 1mL

<u>and</u>

 3mL of blood in a purple top (EDTA) or green top (sodium heparin) tube from an nonrelated control. Clearly label this sample "Normal Control". Minimum sample volume is 1mL
