SUBJECT:	Critical Calcium Threshold Lowered
DATE:	December 11, 2019

Effective December 17th 2019, the McLendon Clinical Laboratories and Hillsborough Hospital Laboratory will lower the critical calcium threshold to 6.0 mg/dL. The change comes from data analysis of critical results from inpatient units, provider feedback, and published literature*. It is important to note that any abnormal calcium result is clinically important and medical intervention should not rely solely upon critical value notification from the laboratory.
