Subject: Changes to HIV Genotyping Test Orders

Effective June 10, 2024, the available reference lab tests for HIV genotyping will change at UNC Medical Center.

The individual tests below will be discontinued:

- LabCorp HIV GenoSure MG (NRTIs, NNRTIs, PIs) [LAB11084]
- LabCorp Genosure Integrase (INIs) [LAB5638]

And replaced with a new orderable test:

✤ LabCorp GenoSure Prime (NRTIs, NNRTIs, PIs, INIs) [LAB115817]

This change will allow a comprehensive resistance profile to be obtained with a single order. There is no change to turnaround time (2-3 weeks), collection methods (3 EDTA or PPT tubes), or the HIV viral load requirement (500 copies/mL).

McLendon Labs Referral Testing Services is unable to process orders from other UNC System Hospitals for this test. HIV Genotyping via Mayo [LAB11084] will remain available for UNC System Hospitals.
