HELP Loan

We have teamed up with UNC Hospital to be allowed to apply for the Healthcare Employee Loan Program (HELP). In brief, here are some of the program highlights:

1. Amount of Loan:

Employees who have been approved for a Healthcare Employee Loan may borrow a minimum of \$50 and a maximum of \$500. This loan is free of interest or fees paid by the employee.

2. Frequency:

An employee will only be permitted one emergency loan during each twelve (12) month period.

3. Repayment:

The employee agrees to repay the balance through payroll deduction. The term of the loan is not to exceed 10 biweekly pay periods.

Office of International Activities

The UNC School of Medicine's Office of International Activities (OIA) supports, promotes, publicizes, and coordinates activities, accomplishments, and opportunities in global health and international medical education. Since 2012, the OIA has supported 119 resident physicians for their international rotations. The OIA awards \$20,000 in global health elective scholarships each year. In addition, they offer a competitive two year Global Health Scholar program with \$8000 funding. The OIA also collaborates with the Office and Occupational Health Services to pay, monitor, and administer preinternational travel vaccinations, on-site HIV PEP and treatment protocol for residents traveling on approved GH electives internationally.
