### Subject: Changes to LAB5505A (Cytogenetics, Constitutional Analysis) Order

Effective April 25th, 2024, test code LAB5505A (Cytogenetics, Constitutional Analysis) has been updated to allow for the selection of testing for karyotype, microarray, and/or familial follow-up (e.g., targeted microarray, FISH, etc.) via a single test code.

Effective April 30th, 2024, test codes:

- LAB5666 (Microarray Analysis)
- LAB5667 (Microarray/20-cell karyotype)
- LAB5672 (Microarray/5-cell karyotype)

will be discontinued. These tests are all orderable through LAB5505A.
