The Managed Care Pharmacy Internship is a two-year paid internship within the Managed Pharmacy Solutions team at UNC Health. Interns will gain experience in the managed care areas of population health, pharmacy benefits management, clinical program development, and analytics. The internship is primarily project-based and allows students to explore various aspects of managed care pharmacy. Our program has four interns total – two PY2s and two PY3s.
