## SINUS EXPOSURE POST-OPERATIVE INSTRUCTIONS

Because a close relationship exists between the upper teeth and our normal sinus anatomy, a communication may develop after extracting these teeth. In most cases, following the instructions below will assist your healing phase. There is a possibility that a second procedure may be required to close a communication if it persists.

## Instructions to Follow:

- 1. Take all prescriptions as instructed
- 2. Do not blow your nose for three days after the procedure
- 3. If you feel the urge to sneeze, sneeze with your mouth open (do not hold your sneeze in)
- 4. Do not use straws for three days after the procedure
- 5. Do not smoke for three days after the procedure
- 6. Eat soft foods for several days (mashed potatoes, yogurt, pasta, eggs, oatmeal etc). Chew on the opposite side as your surgery if possible
- 7. Do not rinse or spit forcefully for three days. You may brush your teeth and allow the water/saliva to gently flow out of your mouth.
- 8. Please contact your surgeon's patient care coordinator if you have any other questions.
